



2009 TRAINING CALENDAR

Courses will be held at the FDTN Training Academy in Indianapolis.

ENGINE COMPANY OPERATIONS I: MAY 18-20, 2009 — AUGUST 24-26, 2009 — NOVEMBER 2-4, 2009

This 3-day course is pure Engine Company Operations. A morning lecture identifies fireground engine company operations, including riding positions and assignments, water supply, stretching and operating the first line, the backup line, and when to use the 2½-inch line. Hands-on skill stations are conducted, under increasingly realistic conditions, to build solid engine company skills. Day 3 is all scenario-based, under live fire conditions, performing as members of an engine company. Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Truck Company Operations course. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

TRUCK COMPANY OPERATIONS I: MAY 18-20, 2009 — AUGUST 24-26, 2009 — NOVEMBER 2-4, 2009

This 3-day course is pure Truck Company Operations. A morning lecture identifies fireground truck company operations, including riding positions and assignments, search, ventilation, tools, and the inside and outside team concept. Hands-on skill stations are conducted, under increasingly realistic conditions, to build solid truck company skills. Day 3 is all scenario-based, under live fire conditions, performing as members of a truck company. Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Engine Company Operations course. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

NEW ENGINE COMPANY OPERATIONS II: SEPTEMBER 21-23, 2009

This 3-day course takes your engine company skills and puts them to the test under realistic fireground decisions. Live fire scenarios are conducted throughout the class, using different building types, to allow students to practice and refine both their engine company skills and their fireground decision making. Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Truck Company Operations II course. PRE-REQUISITE: Engine Company Operations I. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

NEW TRUCK COMPANY OPERATIONS II: SEPTEMBER 21-23, 2009

This 3-day course takes your truck company skills and puts them to the test under realistic fireground decisions. Live fire scenarios are conducted throughout the class, using different building types, to allow students to practice and refine both their truck company skills and their fireground decision making. Note: This course is run simultaneously with the Engine Company Operations course. PRE-REQUISITE: Truck Company Operations I. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

FIREGROUND SEARCH OPERATIONS: SEPTEMBER 14-16, 2009

This 3-day course is dedicated to searching the fireground. A morning lecture identifies the basics of fireground search, including search size-up, search techniques, tools, thermal imaging, residential search, commercial search and VES operations. Hands-on skill stations are conducted under increasingly realistic conditions, to build a solid understanding of fireground search — both strategy and the tactics. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

RAPID INTERVENTION TEAMS: APRIL 6-8, 2009 — AUGUST 10-12, 2009 — OCTOBER 12-14, 2009

THIS COURSE IS A MUST HAVE FOR ALL FIREFIGHTERS! This course teaches rapid intervention skills in 3 stages: Firefighter Survival, Firefighter Rescue, and Rapid Intervention Team Operations. Day one is spent building prevention skills into each firefighter (and preparing them to be members of a RIT). Day two is spent learning the individual techniques and skills involved in firefighter rescue. Scenarios combine all skills learned, under realistic fireground conditions, while operating as a RIT in response to a fireground Mayday. This intense three-day course provides students with the solid foundation and skills-set needed to work as a member of a rapid intervention team on the fireground. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

COMMANDING RIT OPERATIONS: APRIL 8, 2009 — AUGUST 12, 2009 — OCTOBER 14, 2009

This intense one-day course is designed for anyone who may be faced with commanding a RIT or MAYDAY operation. Real-time, hands-on-training, under realistic conditions. The course provides students with a solid foundation, and the basic tools needed, to run a rapid intervention operation on the fireground. Registration: \$195.00/\$175.00 members.

RIT TRAIN-THE-TRAINER: APRIL 6-10, 2009 — AUGUST 10-14, 2009 — OCTOBER 12-16, 2009

This is the most comprehensive course and instructional package available for developing, training and implementing a fire department Rapid Intervention Team program. On days one, two and three, all students participate in FDTN's intense three-day Rapid Intervention Team program with special emphasis on teaching the skills. Days four and five are spent preparing to deliver the complete program to the student's department. The course provides a complete Instructor Manual and accompanying resources for delivery back home. ADVANCED RIT OPERATIONS: MAY 4-6, 2009

This course builds on our basic course and presents students with increasingly difficult RIT operations, under live fire conditions. After reviewing basic RIT positions and assignments, students perform individual rescue and RIT skills under realistic smoke and fire conditions. Day 3 is all scenario-based. Complete RIT operations, under the most realistic conditions you will find, to rescue a firefighter. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

FIREGROUND COMPANY OFFICER: JUNE 8-12, 2009

This is a fireground-based company officer course designed around Common Sense and Solid Fireground Skills! The course is for company officers and firefighters on their way to becoming a company officer. Fireground Company Officer is designed to build a solid and functional fireground officer — both on the fireground and back at the firehouse. Skills will focus on communication, team building, problem solving (through prevention), training, fireground officer skills and performance, the engine company officer, the truck company officer, and Basic Common Sense. It's not a textbook, or sit-on-your butt, course. This course builds and improves company officer skills through hard work and performance! *It takes a lot more than being a good firefighter to be a good company officer — do you have what it takes?* Registration: \$1195.00/\$1075.00 members.

ADVANCED RESCUE SHORING: OCTOBER 2-4, 2009

This course will cover the advanced shoring techniques for use at the heavy operational level. Double & triple raker shores, larger horizontal and vertical shores, 16 foot high laced posts, double and triple slope floor shores and flying shores will also be erected. Multi story shoring scenarios, large opening header fabrication, raker splicing, larger post fabrication will all be covered as well. This is the most comprehensive shoring course there is. Course is taught by Collapse Rescue Systems in conjunction with FDTN. Registration: \$575.00/\$500.00 members.

ADVANCED TRENCH RESCUE: OCTOBER 23-25, 2009

This is a three day course covers the hazards encountered in deep, over 8-feet deep, and intersecting trenches. The students will be taught several ways to shore deep trenches, "L" and "T" trenches, and the different types of extrication techniques, proper rescue site management, as well as the proper safety concepts needed to complete safe and successful rescue.
